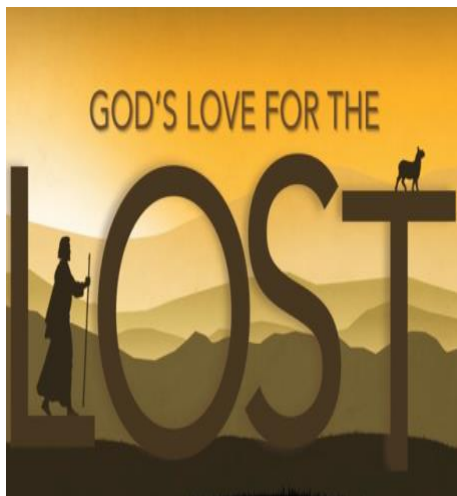
WELCOME to the Church of the Holy Spirit!
